# Floor Decal Installation Guide 

## Tools for Installation



Squeege


Broom


Isopropyl Alcohol


Towel


Masking Tape


Scissors

Prepare the Surface


Be sure that your surface is clean, stable, and in good condition. Any area where you will install floor decals should be completely free of dirt. Any debris that is not cleaned up will likely be trapped underneath finished graphics.


For smooth surfaces such as tile, glass, wood, or concrete, you should saturate a lint-free towel with rubbing alcohol and wipe down the entire surface.


Allow the surface to thoroughly dry.

## Install the Graphic



1 Position your decal onto the floor, then create a center hinge using tape, as shown in diagram 1. Be sure to avoid any seams or grout lines.


Remove the tape, as shown in diagram 4.

(2) Fold back one end of the decal, then peel the decal away from the liner, as shown in diagram 2. Now trim off the top half of the liner.

(5) Now fold back the other half of the decal and remove the liner.


3 Starting at the tape, squeegee from the middle area over to one edge of the decal. Then squeegee from the middle to the other edge. Be sure to overlap your squeegee lines for maximum bonding.

Squeegee the other half of the decal to the surface using the same squeegee pattern, and DONE!
